АПОСТОЛ – EPISTLE

Євреїв 1:10-2:3

“На початку Ти, Господи, заснував землю, і небеса діло рук Твоїх; вони загинуть, а Ти перебуваєш, і всі постаріють, як риза, і як одяг згорнеш їх, і зміняться; але Ти Той самий, і літа Твої не скінчатся”. Кому коли з ангелів сказав Бог: “Сиди праворуч Мене, доки не покладу ворогів Твоїх до підніжжя ніг Тво-їх”? Чи не всі вони духи служіння, що їх посилають служити тим, які мають успадкувати спасіння? Тому ми повинні бути особливо уважні до того, що чули, щоб не відпасти. Бо коли слово, сповіщене через

ангелів, було тверде і всякий злочин і непослух одержували справедливу кару, то як ми уникнемо, не подбавши про таке спасіння, яке, будучи спочатку проповідане Господом, ствердилось у нас тими, хто чув від Нього.

“You, Lord, in the beginning laid the foundation of the earth, and the heavens are the work of Your hands. They will perish, but You remain; and they will all grow old like a garment; like a cloak You will fold them up, and they will be changed. ЄВАНГЕЛІЯ – GOSPEL

Марка 2:1-12

Коли через кілька днів знову прийшов до Капернаума, пішла чутка, що Він у домі. Зразу ж зібралося багато людей, так що вже не вміщалися біля дверей, і Він говорив їм слово. І прийшли до Нього з розслабленим, якого несли четверо. І, не маючи можливості наблизитись до Нього через народ, розкрили покрівлю дому, де Він був, і, розібравши її, спустили постіль, на якій лежав розслаблений. Ісус, побачивши віру їхню, говорить розслабленому: чадо, відпускаються тобі гріхи твої. Були там деякі з книжників, що сиділи і помишляли в серцях своїх: чому Цей так богохулить? Хто може прощати гріхи, крім одного Бога? Ісус, відразу зрозумівши духом Своїм, що вони так помишляють у собі, сказав їм: навіщо так помишляєте в серцях ваших? Що легше сказати розслабленому: прощаються тобі гріхи? Чи сказати: встань, візьми постіль свою і ходи? Та щоб ви знали, що Син Людський має владу на землі відпускати гріхи, говорить розслабленому: тобі кажу: встань, візьми постіль твою та йди до дому твого. Він зараз же встав і, взявши постіль, вийшов перед усіма, так що всі дивувались і прославляли Бога, кажучи: ніколи ще такого ми не бачили.

Mark 2:1-12

And again He entered Capernaum after some days, and it was heard that He was in the house. Immediately many gathered together, so that there was no longer room to receive them, not even near the door. And He preached the word to them. Then they came to Him, bringing a

paralytic who was carried by four men. And when they could not come near Him because of the crowd, they uncovered the roof where He was. So when they had broken through, they let down the bed on which the paralytic was lying. When Jesus saw their faith, He said to the paralytic, "Son, your sins are forgiven you." And some of the scribes were sitting there and reasoning in their hearts, "Why does this Man speak blasphemies like this? Who can forgive sins but God alone?" But immediately, when Jesus perceived in His spirit that they reasoned thus within themselves, He said to them, "Why do you reason about these things in your hearts? Which is easier, to say to the paralytic, 'Your sins are forgiven you,' or to say, 'Arise, take up your bed and walk'? But that you may know that the Son of Man has power on earth to forgive sins", He said to the paralytic, "I say to you, arise, take up your bed, and go to your house." Immediately he arose, took up the bed, and went out in the presence of them all, so that all were amazed and glorified God, saying, "We never saw anything like this!"

Delegate Role

The role of a delegate is to participate in the discussion and voting of the resolutions, UOCC Foundation AGM, elect the chancellor, consistory board, audit committee, and St. Andrew’s College Board.

Also to participate in any breakout session that may be planned regarding the resolutions or other topics.

Resolutions

8.6 At the Sobor, the resolutions will again be presented to all delegates as soon as feasible following the opening of the Sobor. The presentation of the resolutions will be made by members of the Resolutions Committee or by persons designated by the Resolutions Committee.

8.7 The delegates will then be divided into as many discussion groups as there are groups of resolutions. The discussion groups will be representative insofar as possible of all dioceses, all areas of the country, all sizes of parishes, clergy, and membership (age, gender). Each group will discuss each of the major areas under the guidance of a facilitator/recorder and with the assistance of experts in each area (e.g., chairs of Consistory committees). Even though all the membership will have had an opportunity to discuss this material at the parish level, this will be the one opportunity for working out differences that may exist, for example, among various parts of the country, large/small parishes, etc. It is intended that these differences be worked out at this point in order that the final discussion/debate on the floor not be unduly drawn out.

8.8 Ideally, voting on the resolutions will take place on the day following their presentation to the Sobor. Comments/questions from the floor will be limited to two minutes per person. A person may address each resolution only once. concerted effort will be made to alternate between speakers speaking in favour of and against a given resolution. How long each resolution will be discussed, will be at the discretion of the Resolutions Committee?

8.9 Resolutions which have been moved, seconded, and submitted in writing from the floor will be discussed following the voting on the resolutions which were submitted through the process outlined above. There will be a definite time limit (e.g., one hour) established by the Resolutions Committee for the discussion of resolutions from the floor.
