АПОСТОЛ – EPISTLE

Євреїв 4:14-5:6

Отже, маючи Первосвященника Великого, Який перейшов небеса, Ісуса Сина Божого, будемо твердо триматися сповідання нашого. Бо ми маємо не такого первосвященника, який не може страждати з нами в немочах наших, але Такого, Який, подібно до нас, зазнав спокуси в усьому, крім гріха. Тому з дерзновенням приступаймо до престолу благодаті, щоб одержати милість і знайти благодать для своєчасної допомоги. Бо кожний первосвященик, який з людей обирається, для людей настановляється на слу-жіння Богові, щоб приносити дари й жертви за гріхи, який може бути

поблажливий до неуків та заблудливих, тому що й сам обкладений неміччю, і тому він повинен як за народ, так і за себе приносити жертви за гріхи. І ніхто сам собою не приймає цієї чес-ти, але покликаний Богом, як і Аарон. Так і Христос не Сам Собі присвоїв славу бути Первосвящеником, але Той, Хто сказав Йому: «Ти Син Мій, Я нині породив Тебе»; як і в іншому місці говорить: «Ти Священик повік за чином Мелхиседековим».

Hebrews 4:14-5:6

Seeing then that we have a great High Priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession. For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin. Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need. For every high priest taken from among men is appointed for men in things pertaining to God, that he may offer both gifts and sacrifices for sins. He can have compassion on those who are ignorant and going astray, since he himself is also subject to weakness. Because of this he is required as for the people, so also for himself, to offer sacrifices for sins. And no man takes this honor to himself, but he who is called by God, just as Aaron was. So also Christ did not glorify Himself to become High Priest, but it was He who said to Him: “You are My Son, today I have begotten You.” As He also says in another place: “You are a priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek”

ЄВАНГЕЛІЯ – GOSPEL

Марка 8:34-9:1

І, покликавши народ з учениками Своїми, сказав їм: хто хоче йти за Мною, нехай зречеться себе, і візьме хрест свій, і за Мною йде. Бо хто хоче душу свою спасти, той погубить її; а хто погубить душу свою заради Мене і Євангелія, той спасе її. Бо яка користь людині, коли вона придбає увесь світ, а душу свою занапастить? Або що дасть людина взамін за душу свою? Бо якщо хтось посоромиться Мене і Моїх слів у роді цьому перелюбному і грішному, того посоромиться і Син Людський, коли прийде у славі Отця Свого з ангелами святими. І сказав їм: істинно говорю вам, що деякі з тих, які стоять тут, не зазнають смерті, доки не побачать Царство Боже, що прийшло в силі.

Mark 8:34-9:1

When He had called the people to Himself, with His disciples also, He said to them, “Whoever desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me. For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake and the gospel’s will save it. For what will it profit a man if he gains the whole world, and loses his own soul? Or what will a man give in exchange for his soul? For whoever is ashamed of Me and My words in this adulterous and sinful generation, of him the Son of Man also will be ashamed when He comes in the glory of His Father with the holy angels.” And He said to them, “Assuredly, I say to you that there are some standing here who will not taste death till they see the kingdom of God present with power.”

Delegate Role

The role of a delegate is to participate in the discussion and voting of the resolutions, UOCC Foundation AGM, elect the chancellor, consistory board, audit committee, and St. Andrew’s College Board.

Also to participate in any breakout session that may be planned regarding the resolutions or other topics.

Resolutions

8.6 At the Sobor, the resolutions will again be presented to all delegates as soon as feasible following the opening of the Sobor. The presentation of the resolutions will be made by members of the Resolutions Committee or by persons designated by the Resolutions Committee.

8.7 The delegates will then be divided into as many discussion groups as there are groups of resolutions. The discussion groups will be representative insofar as possible of all dioceses, all areas of the country, all sizes of parishes, clergy, and membership (age, gender). Each group will discuss

each of the major areas under the guidance of a facilitator/recorder and with the assistance of experts in each area (e.g., chairs of Consistory committees). Even though all the membership will have had an opportunity to discuss this material at the parish level, this will be the one opportunity for working out differences that may exist, for example, among various parts of the country, large/small parishes, etc. It is intended that these differences be worked out at this point in order that the final discussion/debate on the floor not be unduly drawn out.

8.8 Ideally, voting on the resolutions will take place on the day following their presentation to the Sobor. Comments/questions from the floor will be limited to two minutes per person. A person may address each resolution only once. concerted effort will be made to alternate between speakers speaking in favour of and against a given resolution. How long each resolution will be discussed, will be at the discretion of the Resolutions Committee?

8.9 Resolutions which have been moved, seconded, and submitted in writing from the floor will be discussed following the voting on the resolutions which were submitted through the process outlined above. There will be a definite time limit (e.g., one hour) established by the Resolutions Committee for the discussion of resolutions from the floor.
